**History Visit to the Black Country Living Museum
Wednesday 4th October 2017**

The Year 9 pupils are studying the Industrial Revolution and the social changes that this brought to Britain. As part of the curriculum, we are putting on an exciting new trip to the Black Country Living Museum in Dudley. This living museum gives the pupils the opportunity to experience the workplaces, housing, shops and recreational facilities (including a funfair) of the late Victorian period. We will be given a costumed tour of the town and a lesson taught in the Edwardian school.

Pupils will need to wear their school uniform and sensible footwear, since we will be walking around the site. They will also need to bring a raincoat as much of the tour will take place outside. They will be given some supervised time to visit the living museum's shops; therefore, they may wish to bring a small amount of spending money. Pupils also need to bring a packed lunch.

Your son or daughter needs to arrive at school for **8.00am** because the bus will be leaving at **8.15am prompt**. This is because the journey to Dudley can take up to two hours. They will return to school before 3.45pm the end of the school day.

The cost of the visit is **£24** which will be added to your next termly fees invoice.
