Dear Parents,

Junior School Christmas Performances – Monday 18th December

I am writing to inform you about the Junior School Christmas performances which will take place on Monday 18th December. The performances will be held at St. Jude's Church Hall, Woodborough Road, Nottingham NG3 5HE.

Nursery to Year 2's performance of *A King is Born* will begin at 2.00pm. There will then be a short break for refreshments before Year 3-6's performance of *When Sasha Got Stuck up the Chimney!* at around 2.30pm. All parents, family and friends are invited to both performances.

Please note the arrangements for the rest of the performance day:

There will be no normal lessons on Monday 18th December and teachers will be with the pupils at the hall. Children should be dropped off at St Jude's Hall **no later than 8.40am**; there will be staff on hand from 8.00am at the hall should you require to drop them off earlier. Lunch will be provided but children should bring snacks and water. For anyone unable to attend the performance, pupils may be picked up from St Jude's at the normal time of 3.30pm, otherwise they will be walked back to school for After School Club. Please indicate on the slip overleaf your arrangements for collecting your child at the end of the performance.

As in previous years I would be very grateful if you would assist your child with any lines they may have to learn. I would also be extremely grateful if parents of children in Years 3-6 could source all or part of their child's costume – some ideas are outlined below. Costumes for EYFS and KS1 will be organised in school.

When Sasha Got Stuck up the Chimney costume ideas

Mrs Claus: Red and White clothing, Santa hat, boots

Santa Claus: Red and White clothing; Santa hat; boots; belt

Sasha, Harriet, Tom, Will, Sweeps: Victorian clothing – worn looking

Tooth Fairy: All white

Tooth Ache: All black

Reindeer: Brown bottoms (furry if possible), White top, red braces. Any extra reindeer props including antlers are welcome

Elves: Green and red, preferably red and white stripy socks/tights. Any extra elf props such as ears, headwear, shoes are welcome.
