As we come to the end of another school year, the Friends of Hollygirt committee would like to thank all the staff, parents and children of Hollygirt for their help and support this year.

Over the last 12 months we've been able to fund over **£12,000** worth of new equipment or activities for both senior and junior schools. Our biggest donation was to contribute to the Junior School playground refurbishment by funding the purchase of new astro-turf. This has made an enormous difference to how the playground is used, and given the teachers new opportunities for outdoor teaching.

We've also funded a number of other activities and items; from Kindles to basketball hoops

and indoor curling stones, baby chick brooders, playground equipment and Spanish language plays. All have been funded by the Friends of Hollygirt committee funds.

A big thank you to everyone who joined us for a curry, bought raffle tickets and second hand uniform or just gave up their time to help support one of our events. All contributions, big or small, help us to continue organising events and provide extra equipment to benefit children throughout the school.
