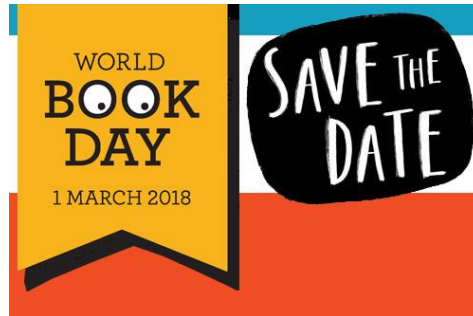

Dear Parents,

This year, World Book Day - the annual celebration of books and reading for children and young people – takes place on **Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> March**. The theme for this year is simply '**share a story**', so children may come **dressed up as any character from a book of their choice**. We are asking all children to **bring their chosen book into school**, so we can see the wide range of books that children enjoy reading.

We are also hoping to raise money for charity on this special day, so pupils are asked to **bring £1 to school**. All children will be given a £1 book token, which they can use in exchange for one of ten special World Book Day books, or they can use it against the price of a book costing £2.99 or more.

Other activities will also be taking place within school during that week, including Year 1 and 2's visit to a local library to participate in a storytelling and drama workshop.
