Premier League Primary Stars Move and Learn

I am pleased to write to inform you that we shall be continuing our partnership with Notts County Football Club (the world's oldest professional club) this term by participating in the Premier League Stars Move and Learn programme. The children in Year Five will be having weekly sessions with representatives from the club who will teach about nutrition and health. These classroom-based sessions will then be followed by some physical activities (such as football, handball, dodgeball and so on).

We ran this programme with last year's Year Fives, and not only did they thoroughly enjoy it, but they got a great deal from it educationally, hence I was delighted to rebook this year. The Year Six pupils will also be joining us for the physical activity sessions (though not the classroom-based work, as they completed this last year).

There is no charge for this course. However, the children will be required to bring their PE kit with them on Thursdays from Thursday 1st March to Thursday 22nd March inclusive. They should wear uniform as normal, and will change at School.
