Junior School Summer Productions – Monday 2nd July 2018

I am writing to inform you about the Junior School Summer Productions which will take place on Monday 2nd July. The performances will be held at St. Jude's Church Hall, Woodborough Road, Nottingham NG3 5HE. The children have spent the summer term working incredibly hard on their shows, which are sure to provide an afternoon of unforgettable entertainment!

Year 1 and 2's performance of *Whiz Wham Alakazam!* will begin at 2.00pm. There will then be a short break for refreshments before Year 3-6's performance of *Through the Decades* at around 2.30pm. All parents, family and friends are invited to both performances. Tickets are available on the door and will cost £5.00 (under 16s free).

Please note the arrangements for the rest of the performance day:

There will be no normal lessons on Monday 2nd July and teachers will be with the children at the hall. **Children should be dropped off at St Jude's Hall between 8.00am and 8.45am** (not before please, as there will be no staff on duty). A packed lunch will be provided, however pupils should bring a snack and water. For anyone unable to attend the performance, pupils may be picked up from St Jude's at the normal time of 3.30pm, otherwise they will be walked back to school for After School Club. Please indicate on the slip below your arrangements for collecting your child at the end of the performance.

Costumes:

We would be very grateful if you would provide your child with a costume for their production. Years 1 and 2 will need to dress as wizards apart from the ice creatures who will need to wear shorts and t-shirts (light blue and white ideally plain no logos).

Years 3 and 4 need to dress according to their character. If children are required to change costume, please note there will be nowhere private to change, so please try to coordinate costumes where possible.

Please see some costume ideas for characters below. If you have any trouble with any costume, please feel free to contact Miss Purchase or Mr Thompson.

Year 6 – wear what they would wear outside of school

Top of the Pops/Newsreader/Euro Host can wear anything appropriate to present a TV programme. Potentially glitz and glam for Euro Host

The Beatles/The Monkees – A suit/smart trousers and white shirt



Football Commentator – sports wear

Football Player – White shirt red shorts

60s Dancers – Bright coloured clothes/miniskirts etc



Astronauts – anything available in white/silver such as boots, gloves, helmet.

ABBA – Anything white/blue/sequined



Star Wars Characters – Anything star wars related – (school has some light sabers)

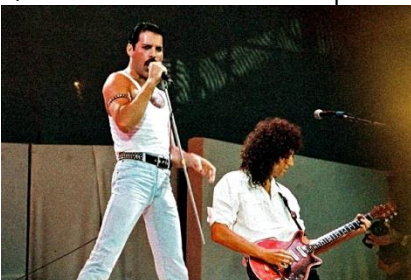
Punks – ripped tops, tartan, boots, band badges, leather, fake piercings and tattoos, spiked up hair
